Regular Meeting of Council for December 20, 2022

## 2022 Budget Presentation #2

Council discussed high-level issues related to the 2023 budget, including:

- The future use and maintenance of Town facilities, including Town Hall;
- The funding and support for downtown beautification and promotion activities;
- Funding options for curbside waste collection;
- Future staffing needs; and
- Funding options for future capital projects.

## Bill 109 & Bill 23 Impacts

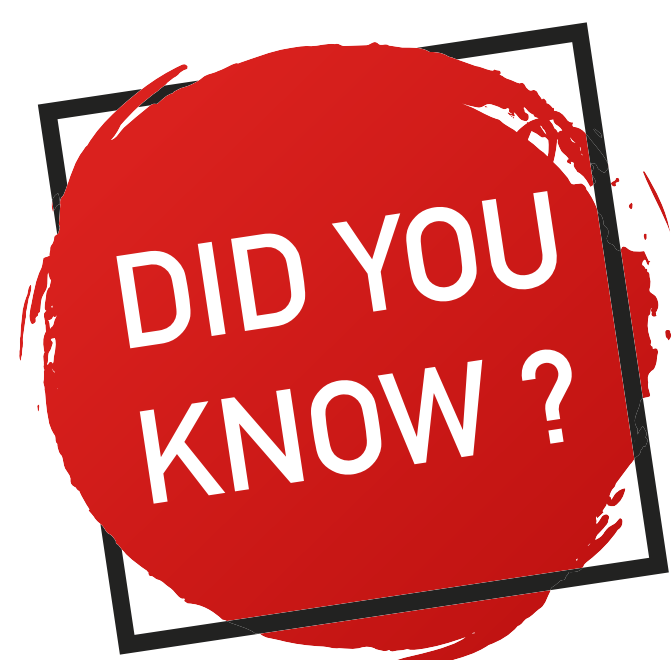

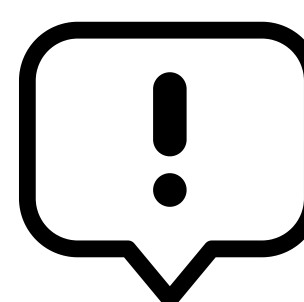
