General Purpose of the position: Join our Utilities team to provide general maintenance of treatment facilities and grounds. Perform the essential implementation of a hydrant maintenance program and assist with in-ground maintenance including traffic control.

2. Data entry and verification including GIS field work, administrative tasks including scanning and filing documents
3. Perform general house-keeping tasks and indoor or outdoor maintenance including cleaning, organizing and painting
4. Assist with in-ground maintenance work including manual labour and traffic control
5. Adhere to all applicable legislation and Town policies
