Regular Meeting of Council for June 25, 2024

Greater Napanee Firefighter Recipient of Ontario Medal for Firefighter Bravery

Greater Napanee Firefighter Mackenzie Grosvenor received the Ontario Medal for Firefighter Bravery after saving an individual from a vehicle collision while off-duty last October. Firefighter Grosvenor was presented with a certificate of recognition at the June 25th meeting from Mayor Richardson.

Deputation - Hydroster

Council heard a <u>presentation</u> regarding the Quinte ESC Project Update from Hydroster. The presentation highlighted a compressed-air energy storage project that has the potential to be located within Greater Napanee.

GIS Dashboards Presentation

Council received a presentation that highlighted a dashboard created by staff that provides an overview of data collected from reports submitted through Access E11. Council was also presented with a dashboard that collects information on Deseronto Transit usage. Renewal of Automatic Aid Agreements for Fire Protection Services with Municipalities Adjacent to the Town of Greater Napanee

Council authorized the Mayor and Clerk to enter into an agreement with adjacent municipalities to receive fire protection services in accordance with the Fire Protection and Prevention Act.

The new agreement will remain in effect for three years, expiring on December 31st, 2027.


OPP Detachment Board

Due to a conflict with eligibility requirements, Councillor Bob Norrie was appointed as the new member of Council on the Lennox & Addington OPP Detachment Board.



What's Happening in Our Municipal Departments:

Community & Corporate Services

Areas of discussion included new hire updates, North Fredericksburgh tennis and pickleball courts that are open for play, South Fredericksburgh AC replacement that is now complete, North Fredericksburgh Community Hall flooring replacement that is scheduled for Monday August 12th, and a bar services summary for May and June. Financial Services

Areas of discussion included supplemental tax bills and in-year adjustments that are now being processed, 2024 insurance renewal that was received from McDougal Insurance which included a 3.9% overall increase, and the accounts payable listing for the period of May 26th to June 14th, 2024. Fire Department

Areas of discussion included the kick off of a smoke and CO alarm program, 7 recruits that graduated on June 13th and are now responding to the department as probationary firefighters, and calls for service that are being integrated into the GIS system. Growth & Expansion Services

Areas of discussion included updates on Bill 185, the Official Plan Public Open House, the Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund, West Bridge Estates Phase 12, the J.J. Infrastructure Services

Areas of discussion included surface treatment applications to be completed the weeks of July 8th and 15th by Greenwood Paving, a point of sale system that will be available at the South Fredericksburgh Waste Disposal Site to accept debit payments, and the South Fredericksburgh Waste Disposal Site summer hours that will begin on Wednesday, July 3rd from 4:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Legislative Services

Areas of discussion included an engagement page on Let's Talk Greater Napanee that was launched to receive feedback on proposed changes to the Dog Control By-law, continuing work with community partners to ensure there is a coordinated approach related to encampments on public property, and weekend and evening parking enforcement that is on-going on a regular basis as of May 1st.
